***V. FULTON COUNTY TRANSIT***

- Mr. Kenny Etherton, with the Fulton County Transit, explained to the committee the services provided by the Fulton County Transit. Also, he reported on a new service being provided by the transit. The transit is now available to pick up customers at their home or at the transit parking lot and deliver the customers to the Amtrack in Fulton County. Mr. Etherton provided a flyer with the fair fees for this service.
- Mr. Mark Davis reported that at the November 21, PADD Board Meeting, Marshall Co. J/E Mike Miller asked him to look at the status of the KY Lock Project. Mr. Courtney and Mr. Davis contacted the Corp of Engineers and were told that there is not enough funding for all the projects that the Corp has going at this time. The priority has been placed on the Olmsted Dam Project.
