I. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Chairman Tony Smith welcomed the guests and members of the Transportation Committee to the meeting. Mr. Smith introduced Ms. May Louise Zumwalt with the Paducah Quilt Museum.

II. WEST KY. QUILT TRAIL

Ms. May Louise Zumwalt, with the Paducah Quilt Museum presented to the committee the project of the West Kentucky Quilt Trail. The KY Arts Council is urging the Quilt Museum staff to facilitate a project that would create a Quilt Highway Trail in Western KY that could eventually join with a similar trail in Eastern KY. The existing trail in Eastern KY has brought an interest in art, quilts, tourism, and lot of new interest by travelers to the smaller communities throughout Eastern Kentucky. Ms. Zumwalt asked the committee for their help in establishing a Quilt Trail in our region.

Any form of communication that's used will be incorporated into the public hearing minutes. Attendance at the meeting is not required for their input to be considered.
