Notice is hereby given that the Kevil City Council unanimously approved a rate increase for all water and sewer customers. The rate increase will be reflected on the SEPTEMBER Bill for consumption beginning around the middle of JULY.

The City Council regrets having to increase the rates. It is noted, however, that the last increase was in 1996 for sewer customers and in 1995 for water customers. Since that time, there have been significant changes in operating expenses and regulatory requirements. The Council feels fortunate to have some of the lowest rates in Ballard and McCracken Counties.
