**Ordinance No. 260**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BARLOW, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE WATER AND SEWER RATE ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF BARLOW ON APRIL 19, 1977 AS AMENDED ON APRIL 21, 1994 AND SEPTEMBER 3, 2002.**

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and desirable at this time that the water rates be changed to accommodate increased costs,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Barlow, Kentucky, Amendment of Section 1 of the rate ordinance of April 19, 1977 as amended April 21, 1994 and September 3, 2002:

**SECTION 1. BASIC MONTHLY WATER AND SEWER RATES.**

That there shall be and there are hereby established from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, monthly rates or charges for the use of and the services rendered by the combined and consolidated municipal waterworks and sewer system of the City, as follows:

**A. Minimum Water Rate.**

The minimum water bill shall be \$13.00 per month, and each water customer shall be entitled to 2,000 gallons of water in each month for such minimum charge.

**B. Meter Rate for Water Usage in Addition to Minimum Charge.**

Subject to the minimum monthly water rate specified above, the following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons of water consumption per month to customers of all size connections:

2,000 - 3,000 gallons	\$17.00

6,000 - 7,000 gallons	\$31.00
7,000 - 8,000 gallons	\$34.00
8,000 - 9,000 gallons	\$37.00
9,000 - 10,000 gallons	\$40.00
10,000 + gallons	\$42.50

**C. Monthly Sewer Rates.**

The rates or charges for sewer service shall be based insofar as possible upon the quantity of water supplied each month to the respective premises and shall be One Hundred Thirty-three Percent (133%) of the monthly water bill determined by the above

water rates. The minimum sewer bill shall be \$22.74 to account for the 133% of the water bill plus the debt service outlined in Letter D.

D. Monthly Sewer Rehabilitation Project Debt Service.

The cost added to the each sewer customer's bill shall be \$5.45 to cover the debt service associated with sewer rehabilitation project.

E. Fire Hydrant Rentals.

All standard fire hydrants (public or private) shall be billed at the rate of \$25.00 per year (payable in quarterly amounts), and the City will pay the sum of \$25.00 per year for each fire hydrant maintained by the City, said sum to be deposited in the same fund as the fund in which all other revenues of the municipal waterworks and sewer systems are deposited.

SECTION 2. ALL OTHER PROVISION OF THE RATE ORDINANCE OF APRIL 19, 1977, AS ENACTED AND AS AMENDED, RATIFIED AND CONFIRMED.

That all provisions of said water and sewer rate ordinance enacted on April 19, 1977, amended on May 19, 1977, June 16, 1986, April 21, 1994, and September 3, 2002; not specifically amended herein are hereby ratified and confirmed, and made part hereof, the same as if copied in full herein.

Section 3. ALL FORMER PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT REPEALED;  
EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.

That all City ordinances order, resolutions, motions or part thereof so far as same may be in conflict herewith are repealed and the Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
