

ORDINANCE 2007- 10 - 03

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES
RELATING TO SEWERAGE RATES**

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Ordinances of the City relating to sewerage rates charged under Section 50.20 SEWER USE RATES; FILING OF SUIT et al., now therefore, and

WHEREAS, the rates charged for water consumption currently set by the Public Service Commission are as follows:

Water Rates

Gallons	Rate per 1000 gallons
First 1000 gallons	\$9.02 (Minimum monthly charge)
Next 9000 gallons	\$5.11 per 1000 gallons
Next 15,000 gallons	\$4.69 per 1000 gallons
Next 25,000 gallons	\$4.27 per 1000 gallons
Next 50,000 gallons	\$3.99 per 1000 gallons
Over 100,000 gallons	\$3.31 per 1000 gallons

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Clinton, Kentucky, that the following rates are hereby established for the use of the sanitary sewer system. All of the rates hereinafter fixed and established are be in and take effect as of Dec. 1-01 2007.

(A) Ordinance #2007-06-2 and any and all other Ordinances which may conflict with this Ordinance are hereby rescinded and the following rates for sewer service and water consumption are hereby established to-wit:

(B) The rates or charges for sewer service inside the city shall be based upon the quantity of water supplied each month to the customer, and the Sewer Rate shall be 133% of the monthly water bill determined by the above water rates. The minimum sewer bill shall be \$12.00 to account for the 133% of the water bill.

(C) The Sewer rate for sewer only customers in the city will be a \$30 flat rate.

(D) The Sewer Rate will be 150% of the monthly water bill for customers outside the City limits. The Sewer Rate for sewer only customers outside the city limits will be a \$35 flat rate.

(E) The nonresidential and/or commercial customer's sewer bill will be 133% of the monthly water bill.

(F) Any sewerage discharged after a cut-off notice has been duly issued may be collected by suit in which the property owner may be made a party, and judgment obtained against the user and against the property owner. If suit is filed an additional penalty of \$100 shall be assessed for each month of arrearage.
