 Clean-up and recovery efforts including demolition, repair, renovation and reconstruction of damaged and destroyed structures, facilities and lands located within the disaster area and in offshore areas related to the emergency or disaster.
Employment related to the delivery of appropriate humanitarian assistance, such as assistance with providing food, clothing and shelter, in the immediate aftermath of the tornadoes.

Eligible Participants to Work Include:

- Individuals who are temporarily or permanently laid off as a consequence of the disaster;

- Other eligible dislocated workers;
- Long-term unemployed workers; and
- Self-employed individuals who become unemployed or significantly underemployed as a result of the disaster.
- Eligibility does not relate to an individual's personal loss in the tornadoes.
